True To Life Foundation Spotlight

True To Life Foundation is a nonprofit organization that focuses on providing programs and services for Chicago land families. Our services focus on crisis intervention, parent education, and parent support groups which foster positive self-awareness. True To Life Foundation empowers families through our guided parent child interaction in the home visiting program. The purpose is to encourage early childhood education in high risk and low income families.

The ultimate goal of True To Life Foundation is to empower parents to be leaders and to make positive impacts in their families and their communities. The four major components of services provided to participating families include home visits with the parents, child and direct service provider group meetings about early childhood developments, developmental screenings for young children, and linkages and referrals to community networks and resources. These components allow for a comprehensive social service program that reflects the promotion of nonprofit resource management and community integration.

True To Life Community Groups

Each month Parent Educators host a workshop at their school based site which focuses on the needs and support of our teenage parents. The goal of each month is to present a topic that creates improved parenting skills as well as provide information on related social support skills. The focus for the month of April is on "Prevention of Child Abuse/ Neglect." Next month, Parent Educators will be focusing on "Discipline/ Anger Management."

These groups run in tandem with our larger Community Groups which seek to bring our clients together in a larger more diverse interactive sphere. The parents and their children come together to participate in arts and crafts as well as informational presentations based on the monthly topic.

True To Life Foundation Spotlight Afterschool Program

True to Life is a state licensed afterschool program equipped with a computer lab with monitored online access, and a library. The afterschool program is a five day a week program that provides homework assistance, recreational, artistic, and creative development. The program will be coming to an end to coincide with the last day of school which occurs Friday June 29th. Registration for next semester's program will occur in July of 2015; more information will be provided closer to the date.

Summer Camp

Our Sizzln' Hot Fun Summer Program will kick off this year in June. The seven week long summer program provides a full day summer camp experience for school age youth, ages 5 to 14, in the Chicagoland area. Summertime at True To Life Foundation renders a fun, loving, and educational learning experience. We aim to stimulate and cultivate the interests within our children, and increase their opportunity for cultural expose to. The theme for this year is Myself and The World



The campers will participate in weekly bowling tournaments, field trips to the city museums, the city's police and fire department and more. As an incentive of participation, through our partnership with Chicago City of Learning, the campers will be able to obtain badges. These badges are a representation of their learning pathways and an indication of their achievement.

For the past two years True To Life Foundation has been in partnership with Perspectives Charter School Internship Program. The internship program enables junior students of Perspective to gain hands on experience within a professional setting. The objectives and vision of the Perspective Internship Program is to inspire students to work towards higher academic achievement through exposure to the professional world, and to teach students of the basic protocol used in a professional arena.

This year True To Life continued to carry on that vision by hosting a junior intern. The junior intern was able to experience an in depth view at children and family social services as it relates to program implementation and direct services. The intern was also able to experience firsthand the insight of what various careers are like by shadowing several True To Life professional staff members. Through exposure to a Home Visitor, Social Worker/ Case Manager, & Supervisor the intern was able reassess and map out the pros and cons and of her career interests.
